Welcome to the 20th World Congress on Psychosomatic Medicine! The Congress offers a unique opportunity to address new approaches to health care within the psychosomatic framework. It consists of advanced courses, update lectures, symposia, interactive clinical case conferences, workshops and poster sessions.

On Wednesday, Sep 23, there are many cutting-edge advanced courses on the clinical domains of psychosomatic medicine. These courses are held in a building close to the Conference Center. Please follow directions for the courses.

The following three days are characterized by three tracks which allow the participant to select what may be more suitable.

One track consists of a series of update lectures (supplemented by plenary lectures) which focus on emerging trends and perspectives in psychosomatic medicine.

The second track consists of scientific symposia on selected topics where surveys of the literature and new findings are presented.

The third track includes clinical case presentations (a novelty of this conference compared to previous psychosomatic meetings), where a participant presents a clinical case, which is offered for general discussion. The third track has some clinical symposia as well.

The main form of scientific communication chosen by this conference involves poster presentations which are divided in two types. One is represented by clinical cases presentations which undergo discussion. The other type is the involves new data and hypotheses.

There are also special lectures, symposia, meet the editor, meet the author sessions, during the time that is allocated to poster presentations.

All contributions are included in a special issue of the international Journal PanMinerva Medica, which is fully listed in Current Contents and PubMed. Abstracts are arranged in alphabetical order according to the last name of the first author.

The Congress includes also a fourth track in Italian. Psychosomatic medicine in Italy has undergone major developments, under the leadership of the GRP (Gruppo per la Ricerca in Psicosomatica). This track includes both symposia and clinical case presentations.

The wide international participation that the conference has attracted is a sign of the vitality and importance of the International College of Psychosomatic Medicine. We encourage you to join the College if you have not done it before; it is possible to do it also during the conference.

We hope that this is going to be for you a highly satisfactory experience, including visiting Torino.
